### What to wear under your gown on graduation day:

**Girls:** If your dress is longer than your gown, the dress must be black. Wear dark shoes.

**Boys:** Wear dark slacks, preferably black or navy. Also wear a white dress shirt, tie, and dark dress shoes.

**Caps:** These should be worn straight and level and **not** on the back of the head. The tassel of the cap should be worn hanging on the right; it will be moved to the left after you receive your diplomas.
